Stepping into the Past, Living in the Present, Journeying toward the Future: A Program for Associates, Agrégées, Partners in Mission, and Friends of the Joseph Family – May 1-7, 2023

Welcome to Le Puy! Come and enjoy an exciting opportunity to discover, in fresh ways, the history, spirituality, and charism of the Family of Joseph as it unfolds for a new day. Come and listen to the ageless echo of the footsteps of the first members on the cobble-stone streets of France. Let them touch your soul. Explore the resonance and relevance of the echo from the past animating us to life in the present. Journey, with others, into the promise and hope of an evolving and unknown future at the very heart of this beautiful and dynamic charism. Come to appreciate ever more deeply your special place, your own call and journey into the mystery of relationship with God and with others. Embrace anew the spirituality that calls us always to "expansive and inclusive love" in the realities of the contemporary world. This seven-day program will integrate prayer, reflection, presentations and sharing, visits to special sites in the story of the Family of Joseph and the enjoyment of "walking together" in the movement of the Spirit. Presenter: Sr. Mary Rowell, CSJ, is a Sister of St. Joseph in Canada and is vocation and first formation director for her Congregation. She currently works in retreat and environmental ministries at Villa St. Joseph in Cobourg, Ontario. In that capacity, Sr. Mary provides presentations and retreats across Canada and the United States, many of which focus on the CSSJ charism for all members of the "Joseph Family". She also facilitates general chapters for various Congregations.

Mission Effectiveness: The Charism Alive in CSSJ Ministries September 2-9, 2023

This program offers a pilgrimage for lay partners in mission and provides an immersion experience into the original spirit and global dimension of the charism and spiritual tradition of the Sisters of St. Joseph. The Lace is Not Yet Finished -- September 16-22, 2023

In each generation since, the Holy Spirit has awakened God's compassionate presence in the hearts of women to respond to the ever-changing needs of the people of God. In this program participants will get in touch with and claim once again the transformative power of this charism in our midst and into the future.

The Prophetic Stance of Relationship: The Two Trinities as a Model of Dynamic Love -- September 29 - October 5, 2023

The relationality between and among the Uncreated and Created Trinities – being an expression of Divine mystery, providence, and plan – calls all to a radical response. This is the prophetic nature of the spirituality of the Sisters of St. Joseph which calls us to move relationally into the world, with *the dear neighbor without distinction*. This program offers a pilgrimage of the heart for all who are drawn to the charism of unifying love. In this program, we will explore the prophetic nature of our call, using the model of the Two Trinities. We will discover how obstacles to inner freedom, grief and loss, and the rapid change and transition so prevalent today are invitations to radically respond, bringing Triune relationship and love alive in the world. The week-long experience offers a rhythm of input sessions, interactive participation, and reflection, as well as an orientation to the city of Le Puy and visit to the Kitchen.

Presenter: Sr. Linda Buck, CSJ is a Sister of St. Joseph of Orange and has a background in spirituality, theology, leadership, initial formation, and psychology. She is the Executive Director of the Leadership Collaborative and works with individuals and congregations to foster transformation within their hearts and systems.
